Trexler Farm Events Now at Santiam Golf Club

STAYTON, ORE.— At a Santiam Golf Club board meeting on January 16, 2012, Trexler Farm of Stayton, Ore. entered into a strategic partnership with the Golf Club in Aumsville, Ore. to use the club's existing clubhouse for special events. The clubhouse, located at 8724 Golf Club Rd SE, has a capacity of as many as 250 people.

The Sandtrap Deli, which just celebrated its two year anniversary, will continue to operate under the direction of the Golf Club board of directors. The board opened this deli with the purpose of providing food and beverages as a benefit to golf patrons.

Trexler Farm has made its mark over the past few years by providing farm fresh bakery items; healthy, high fiber lunch options; and wine from the old Mehama Fish Hatchery. “It is so great to have such a beautiful location to use as a homebase,” says Trexler of the clubhouse. “I am extremely excited to bring the Trexler Farm charm to events happening at Santiam Golf Club.”

Sharlene's vision is to create a warm and welcoming environment for tournaments and events, much like what she's established at the Trexler Farm Mehama Fish Hatchery. Best known for its Farm Store Café, Trexler Farm is home to many lunch gatherings, business meetings and special occasions. In fall of 2010, Trexler Farm opened the “Boat Room” for private parties and events. Since then, Trexler Farm has created a devoted following of many groups and organizations. Most recently, the café has catered events at other locations such as Anthony Hall in Sublimity and The Grand Ballroom in Salem.

“The Golf Club has one of the best commercial kitchens in the Mid-Willamette Valley,” Golf Club president Peter Whitney says. “This partnership will help us utilize the kitchen through a top-notch catering business. It looks like a win-win situation for both parties. This should draw people to the golf course for events, as well as to play golf.”
